Soon after the PG Profession, I was selected by the Government to work as a Caretaker Cum Counsellor in one of the Children's Home (Child in Conflict with Law) in Kerala. It was my career's first experience. It gave me extraordinary experiences regarding crime and the children's involvement in crime related activities and how to bring them back to Social Norms and how they can be useful as true citizens of the country.

I did my M.PHIL in social work from Bharathidasan University specialized in family and child welfare. In these two years of the programme, I had the ample opportunities of studying Gerontology of Social Work. It is because of my Guru and Head of the Department Dr. Ilango Ponnusawmy, a UGC Professor and a Pioneer in social work in India. His life's major works were always centred on old age. I attended many seminars and conferences based on old age themes.
