We also provide training on safety and security to protect them from the high risk of abuse and exploitation they often face.

With an extensive network spanning schools, colleges, universities, communities, private corporates and churches, I aspire to promote the dignity, well-being, and rights of older persons, fostering positive transformations in their lives.
